WHY WE PUT THIS IN WRITING

Straight answers on what All-on-4® really costs.

If you've researched All-on-4® dental implants, you've probably seen a wide range of prices — some suspiciously low — and plenty of centers that won't give you a number at all until you're sitting in the chair. We think that's backwards. This guide lays out exactly what full-arch implant treatment costs at Aria Dental Implant Center in Phoenix, what that price does and doesn't include, and how to read anyone else's quote so you're comparing apples to apples.

OUR ACTUAL PRICING

Here are the real numbers.

ALL-ON-4®

\$12,500 / arch

Starting price · cash or check

- Custom zirconia final teeth included
- General anesthesia included
- A full arch of fixed teeth on four implants

ALL-ON-6

\$14,999 / arch

Starting price · cash or check

- Custom zirconia prosthesis included
- General anesthesia included
- Six implants for added support

Prices are per arch and reflect cash or check payment. A consultation and 3D CT scan are required before any treatment plan is finalized. Some patients may not have enough bone to support all six implants; your candidacy for All-on-6 is confirmed at your consultation.

READING A QUOTE

Why our price often looks higher than the ad you saw.

Here’s the trick behind a lot of “\$X,XXX All-on-4®” billboards: the headline number frequently covers only the surgery and a temporary acrylic denture. The things that actually make treatment work — and last — get added back later. When you see a very low advertised price, ask what it excludes.

The acrylic-vs-zirconia catch.

Many rock-bottom prices are for a full-arch acrylic denture, not the stronger, more natural-looking zirconia teeth most patients actually want. Upgrading to zirconia later can add thousands. At Aria, your custom zirconia teeth are part of the price you see — not an upsell.

HOW WE COMPARE

Full-mouth All-on-4®, side by side.

Full-mouth treatment means both arches — upper and lower. Patients who consulted large national implant centers before coming to us have told us they were quoted \$38,000 to \$55,000 for a full mouth of All-on-4®. Here's how that compares to Aria's transparent, all-inclusive pricing:

Aria's full-mouth figure reflects our starting All-on-4® price of \$12,500 per arch (cash or check) for two arches, with your custom zirconia teeth and general anesthesia included. The \$38,000–\$55,000 range reflects prices that patients have reported being quoted at other implant centers; we have not independently verified those quotes, and pricing varies by provider, materials, and individual case.

YOUR EXACT NUMBER

What determines your total.

One arch or two

Upper, lower, or a full mouth (both arches). Full-mouth treatment is two arches.

All-on-4® vs All-on-6

Whether your bone supports four or six implants per arch, confirmed by your 3D CT scan.

Extractions needed

Whether any remaining teeth need to be removed as part of your treatment.

Bone & candidacy

The angled All-on-4® approach often avoids grafting, but your anatomy is reviewed individually.

THE NEXT-DAY TEETH QUESTION

Final teeth the day after surgery — what the speed really costs.

Some heavily advertised implant centers offer final zirconia teeth the day after surgery. Next-day delivery is impressive — but it comes at a premium. Patients who consulted these centers before coming to us have told us they were quoted \$45,000 to \$60,000 for a dual arch (both arches).

What the next-day sales pitch doesn't mention.

A zirconia prosthesis delivered the day after surgery is designed and milled before your gums and bone have finished healing. As your mouth heals and changes shape, a good percentage of these prosthetics have to be adjusted, have material added, or be completely remade — often within the first six months. Most patients end up back in the chair either way. “Next-day” rarely means “done.”

The Aria approach: two to four weeks, for almost half the cost.

At Aria, you leave surgery with a fixed temporary prosthesis the same day — you're never without teeth. Your final custom zirconia teeth are delivered in about two to four weeks. Our digital workflow deliberately takes a little longer because we design your final zirconia after your fit, bite, and esthetics are verified — so your teeth are right the first time.

The three-week question.

Choosing Aria over a next-day zirconia center typically saves patients \$15,000 to \$25,000 on a dual arch. Are three weeks worth that amount? We think that's a question every patient deserves to be asked — before they sign.

The \$45,000–\$60,000 range reflects quotes patients have shared with us for dual-arch treatment at centers offering next-day zirconia delivery; we have not independently verified those quotes. Delivery timelines, adjustment and remake experiences vary by provider and by each patient's healing.

THE HONEST VERSION

Insurance & financing.

Insurance: most dental plans treat implants as a major service and cap their annual maximum well below the cost of full-arch treatment. Some of our patients have told us their plans reimbursed roughly \$1,400–\$1,800, but coverage varies widely — we'll help you understand what your specific plan is likely to do.

Financing: we never want cost to stand between you and a healthy, confident smile. We offer flexible monthly payment options through CareCredit, Cherry, and Proceed Financial, and many patients are surprised how manageable a monthly payment can be compared with years of denture adhesives, relines, and replacements.
